INFORMATION ON THE CLINICAL ROTATION, APPLICATION CRITERIA

It is available for sixth year students at WYCKOFF HEIGHTS MEDICAL CENTER, New York, (<http://www.wyckoffhospital.org/>).

Duration:

Long term rotation (core and elective): with USMLE Step 1.

Short term rotation (maximum 12 weeks): with USMLE Step 1.

All students must apply through the Coordinating Center for International Education (CCIE) of the university, and CCIE will guide the students through the application/administrative process (Contact person: Ms. Adrienn Gagna-Szakó (adrienn@edu.unideb.hu))

The following documents must be submitted to the CCIE at least two months before the anticipated date of rotation.

1. [Filled NYSED Application Form](#)
2. A letter of good standing from the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine (provided by Ms. Éva Ludánszki, Registrar's Office).
3. Copy of USMLE Step 1 exam
4. Certificate of completion of the Infection Control Test
5. Check payable to NYSED (12 weeks or less: 30 USD, more than 12 weeks: 20 USD)
6. [Completed WHMC Application Form](#)
7. Back ground check
8. Medical Liability or Malpractice Insurance
9. Updated health report/record – a copy of the following reports must be completed within the past 365 days before starting a rotation:
 - Mumps/ Measles/ Rubeola/ Rubella/ Varicella - Titters vaccination record (Report must also include titer levels)
 - Hepatitis B - Titters / Vaccination Records
 - PPD
 - CXR - If PPD pos(+)
 - Physical Health Assessment
 - Annual Drug Screening
 - Seasonal Influenza Vaccine Proof September of the current year - March of the next year

Other information:

1. Fee: 300 USD/week for participation in the program. This is paid to our University before starting the practice and the University transfers it to the hospital according to the agreement.

This fee is the compensation to the hospital for the administrative and professional services provided during the practice. About the reduction of tuition fee paid for our University, please contact the Coordinating Center for International Education (Ms. Anett Galvácsi).

2. The booklet with the requirements of the sixth year is available at the Registrar's Office (Ms. Éva Ludánszki). The student has to take this booklet to the Wyckoff Heights Medical Center, and at the end of the rotation a signature is needed from the supervisor.

3. The student has to hold private health- and malpractice insurance during the practice.

4. Before application the student has to submit a letter to the Educational Subcommittee saying that he/she would like to spend X weeks clinical rotation from X subject in Wyckoff Heights Medical Center.
